



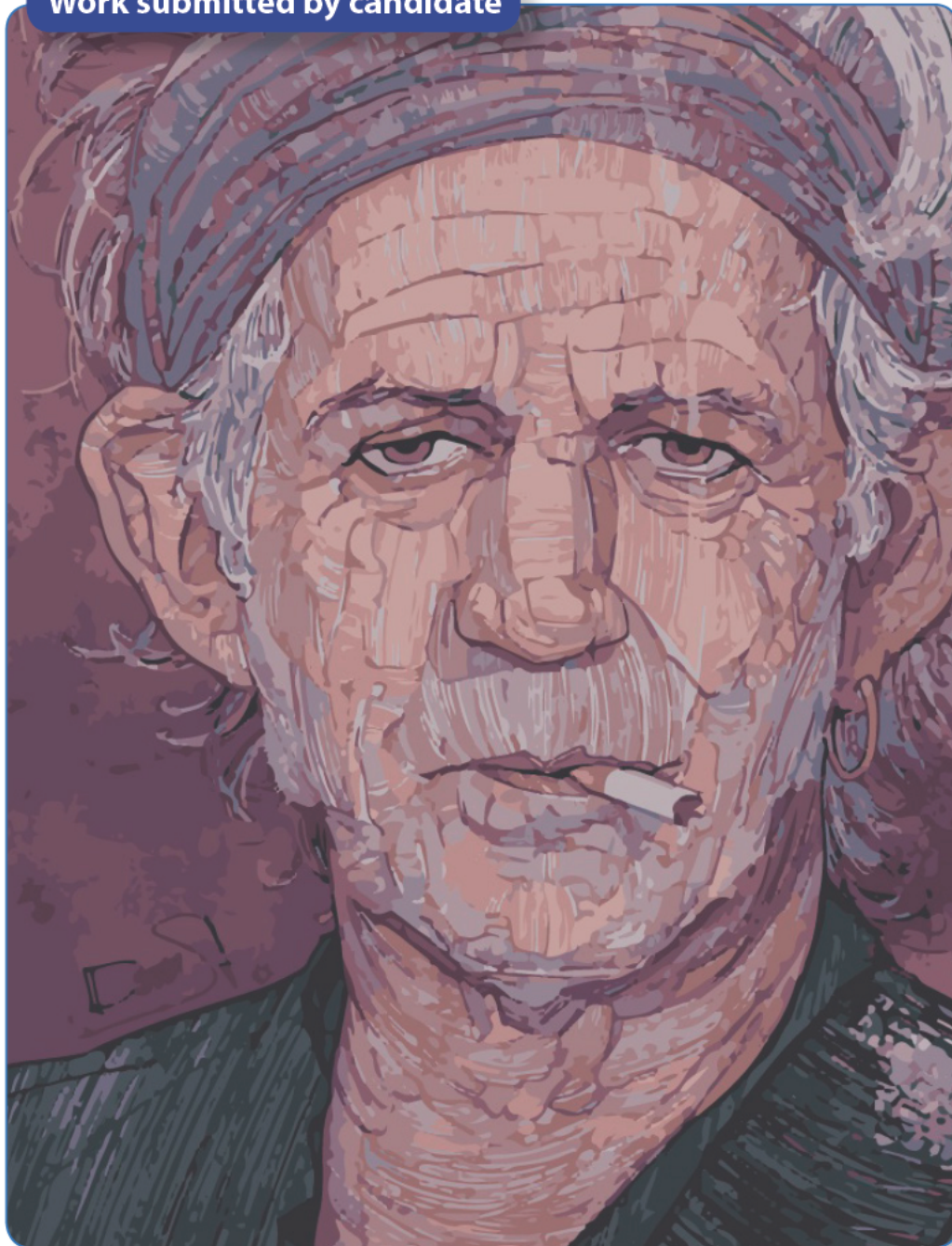

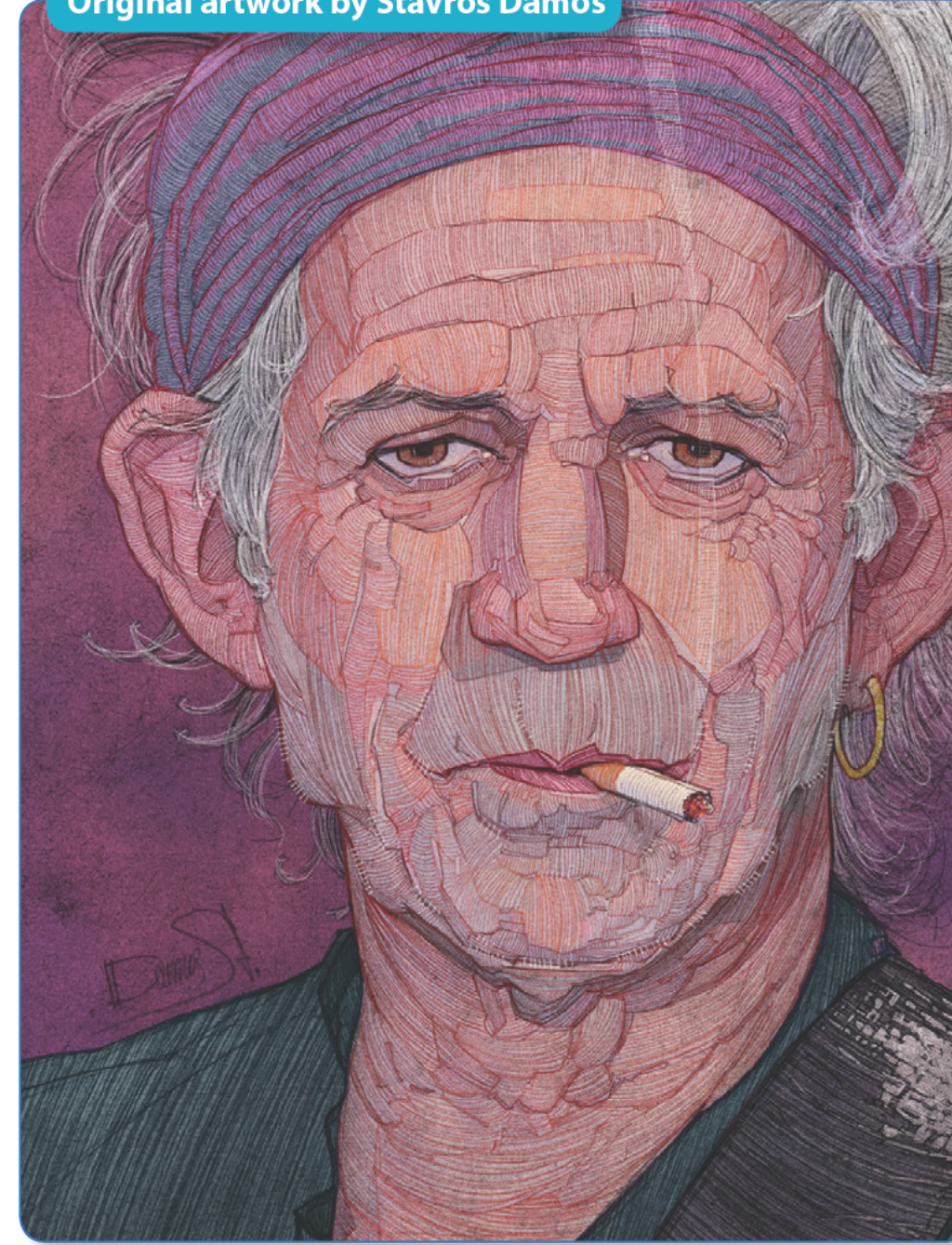
Comments

The candidate has made minor alterations to a pre-existing artwork with digital image editing software, without citation.

The signature of the original artist is still perceptible above the left shoulder of the candidate's submission. If the work was described as an experiment into digital image editing techniques, then it could have constituted an acceptable submission.

As it stands, this submission is seen as academic misconduct in the form of plagiarism.
